Montessori pedagogy

Respect and consideration are important words for us. We believe in child-centered education that focuses on participation, reasoning and respect for each other's differences. At Stellatus, many different cultures and traditions meet and each child is acknowledged. Our Montessori methodology inspires creativity and imagination. Our utmost ambition is to provide a learning environment where each child can manage, research and question information. We provide this atmosphere every day through thinking, reasoning and discussing.

English profile

It takes courage to learn a new language. We promote confidence and involvement so that each child dares to try. At Stellatus, we use English regularly so that it is a natural part of the day. Students learn English in a variety of ways through song, theatre, reading and writing. We recognize traditions and customs from English-speaking countries throughout the year. The main part of our instruction, however, is conducted in Swedish.

Stellatus is an independent school

An independent school is a school that does not belong to the city or county council. Stellatus belongs to "montessorifriskolan Stellatus Ekonomisk Förening" (association). The association's board makes decisions about all strategic questions. The daily operations are also guided by the school board. The school follows the government curriculum and syllabus goals.

Our own after-school program

We have an after-school program available to all Stellatus students. The school and after-school program operate under the same philosophies. During the after-school program, there is time for both planned activities and relaxation. Students participate in planning the activities. The staff members are well known to the children as they are at school throughout the day.
